## Pebble Beach PHIL HILL SCHOLARSHIPS

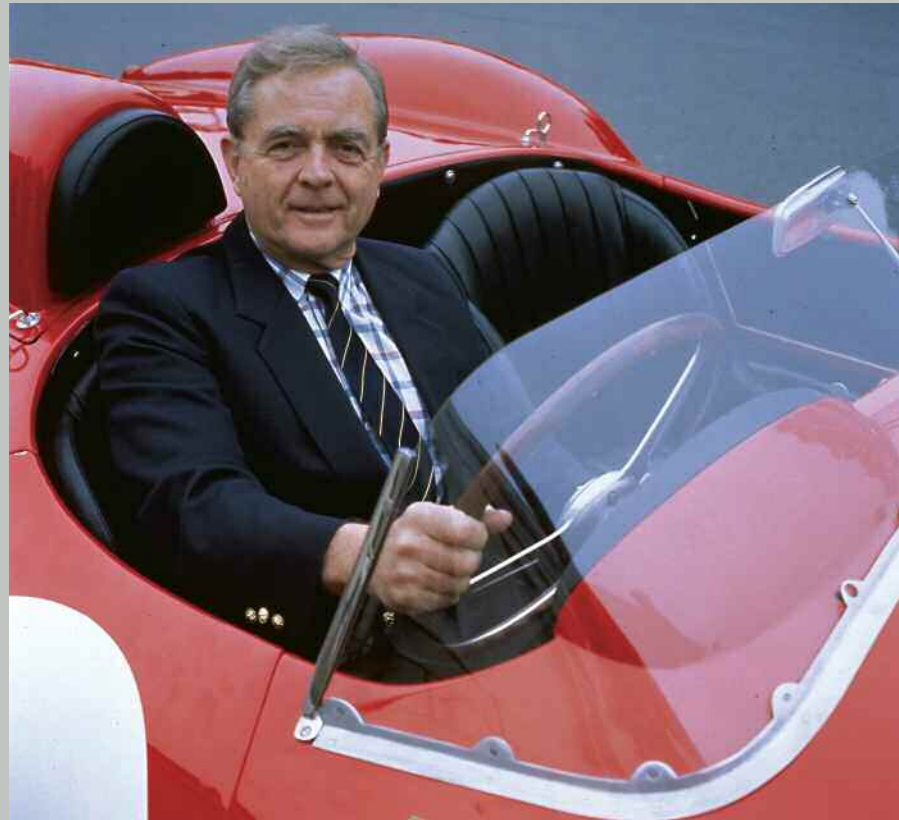
To honor Phil Hill, a steadfast supporter of this event from its beginning and a dear friend to many of us, the Pebble Beach Company Foundation has established the Pebble Beach Phil Hill Scholarships.

Phil, the 1961 Formula One World Drivers' Champion, began his association with Pebble Beach by capturing wins at the 1950, 1953 and 1955 Pebble Beach Road Races. The early Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance was held in tandem with the Pebble Beach Road Races, and Hill, who loved all manner of cars, seldom missed it. Over the years, he participated as enthusiastic entrant time and again, winning Best of Show on two occasions, and he served as our longest tenured Judge.

Phil collapsed amidst the events of Pebble Beach Automotive Week last summer, and he passed away a few days later, at age 81. We all dearly miss him.

The Pebble Beach Phil Hill Scholarships will be awarded to college-age students pursuing degrees in fields related to Phil's many passions—fields like the arts and music as well as engineering and transportation.

The Rev. Paul Woudenberg, who has served as the voice of this Concours for 30 years, has agreed to work with the Foundation, the Hill family and others to set forth guidelines for the scholarship application and distribution process. The Pebble Beach Company Foundation will act as administrator of these scholarships.
